

Homeowner's Trash & Recycling Guide

Pro Disposal & Recycling will collect unlimited household trash each week. However, make sure all trash is bagged and placed in a closed container to protect it. There is a 40-pound limit per can/bag, and all animal waste must be bagged. Pro Disposal & Recycling will also collect up to 15 bags of yard waste per week. Branches and brush must be cut into 4-foot lengths and tied securely in 24-inch diameter bundles. Limit: 10 bundles per week.

Recycling is picked up on the same day as your trash, on an every-other-week schedule (see calendar). Make sure to place recycle bins a few feet from your trash and have it out at curbside by 7 a.m. on the day of collection. Two FREE 18-gallon recycle bins per household may be picked up at the City of Lone Tree (9220 Kimmer Drive) or you may order a 65-gallon wheeled cart at www.cityoflonetree.com/recyclecart.

Pro Disposal & Recycling is unable to accept any liquid waste or batteries. A clean-up fee will be added if your trash contains these items.

For special pickups or large items such as construction debris, house cleanouts or furniture, call Pro Disposal & Recycling at 303-791-3827 to obtain a quote and schedule a pickup.

At Your Door is the City's household hazardous waste service provider. They collect items that should not be placed in the trash or recycled. Call At Your Door at 1-800-449-7587 to obtain a quote and schedule a pickup. Electronics recycling is also available.

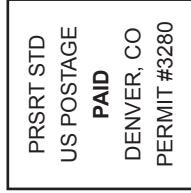
Recycle: aluminum, paper bags, cardboard, glass bottles/jars, junk mail, magazines/catalogs, newspaper, office paper, phone books, Styrofoam/plastic, steel/aerosol cans and milk/juice cartons.

Do NOT recycle: plastic bags, Tyvek overnight mail folders, plastic egg cartons, six-pack ring holders or batteries.
