Meeting Minutes

1. Call to Order

2. Approval of the June 20, 2016 Meeting Minutes

Ann Hargett moved and Nikki Crouse seconded to approve the June 20, 2016 minutes as amended. The motion passed unanimously by those members present.

3. August Luncheon Update

August Bingo has been confirmed. Joyce has fun prizes and Nikki will oversee bingo calling.

4. 2017 L&AW Budget Discussion

The Committee has decided that they will pursue offering regional seminars every two years. Therefore the 2017 budget, supported and approved by City Council, can be less than in 2016 and account for one hosted event, plus food, in the event hall. Kristen will work with Arts Center staff to draft a budget that reflects the cost of room rental and food for one event.

5. Volunteers in Policing Speaker Request Discussion

Kristen let the Committee know that she was contacted by a representative of the VIP program who was interested in sharing the opportunity with luncheon attendees. Since lunch programming is scheduled through the middle of next year, we've found room at the October luncheon to accommodate two speakers – Scott Hall, re. Men's health, and an overview of the VIP program.

6. Senior Living Choices Seminar Planning

The committee decided to order 1,000 tri-fold brochures and intends to hand them out to our speakers and those on the resource list so they can help promote the event.

Mark Koebrick from 9news is confirmed as our MC and Joyce will inquire with Colorado and Co. to see if we can promote the event through their show. Other marketing will include getting an article in the paper in late September.

7. Croquet Pot Luck Update

The event timing has been adjusted to reflect the difference in the pavilion rental length and the actual length of the event. Guests can expect to attend from 5:00 pm – 7:30 pm.

8. Future Luncheon Speakers

9. Other Agenda Items
