In the early morning hours of Saturday, June 22, 2024, the Lone Tree Police Department received a 9-1-1 call from an 18-year-old male, stating he had been shot in the shoulder. Officers responded to the area of a gas station near Lincoln Avenue and Commons Street and located the victim. The victim stated two suspects got into his car and one of them shot him while they were in the Heritage Hills neighborhood. The two suspects then left the area on foot. The victim was transported to Sky Ridge Medical Center. Officers notified the on-call Investigations Team and they responded. At 3:55AM, a Code Red message was sent out by the Lone Tree Police Department in the area around where the incident occurred as a public safety precaution.

As officers and detectives investigated the incident, it was discovered that a group of people, including juveniles and young adults, were at a residence in the 9500 block of Winding Hill Way. There was an altercation between several males who were inside a vehicle parked near the residence and that is when the victim was shot.

The involved parties were contacted inside the residence. Two juvenile males were arrested and booked into a juvenile detention facility for several charges to include Attempted 2nd Degree Murder and Robbery. Neither of the suspects nor the victim live in the City of Lone Tree. A firearm was also located and collected. The victim has since been treated and released. This appears to be an isolated incident between associates and there is no danger to the public.
