At approximately 6:52 a.m. on Tuesday, December 3, 2024, the Lone Tree Police Department received a 9-1-1 call of “shots fired” from a male, stating he, along with four additional passengers, were traveling on southbound I-25 near County Line Road. The caller reported a driver of a black sedan was driving aggressively. The driver of the sedan pulled next to the passenger side of the victim’s vehicle displaying a handgun. The suspect shot one round into the front passenger side bumper while traveling approximately 80 mph. Fortunately, the shots did not cause any injuries.

Officers and detectives responded to the victims and discovered the victims recorded the suspect vehicle and its license plate with a cell phone. This information provided helpful information on the suspect vehicle and a potential suspect. Detectives immediately began searching for the suspect’s vehicle utilizing area cameras.

At approximately 1:30 p.m. a Lone Tree detective located the suspect vehicle in the area of Main Street and South Chambers Road within the Town of Parker. With the assistance of the Parker Police Department, Lone Tree Police detectives took the suspect safely into custody.

The suspect is identified as 27-year-old Denver resident, Oscar Lozoya-Borrego. Lozoya-Borrego was arrested and booked at the Douglas County Justice Center for several charges to include five counts of Attempted First Degree Murder. He is currently being held on a \$500,000 bond.

The suspect vehicle was later searched, and a firearm was located and collected. This appears to be an isolated incident and there is no danger to the public.
