

## **Guidelines For Roofing in The City of Lone Tree**

## Roof Inspections: 303-225-4941

- A **Mid-Roof Inspection** is required for all roof types.
  - 20%-80% of the roofing may be installed
- A Final Roof Inspection is required for all roofing materials
  - No ladder is required for final inspections unless noted on the mid-roof.
- Inspections requested by midnight will be scheduled for the next business day. Typically roof
  inspections are done between 2-3 pm. Specific times may be requested. <u>Permits with no activity of 6</u>
  months or more will be considered an abandoned project and voided.

## **Design Criteria for Roofing**

- City's adopted codes are the 2021 International Residential Code (IRC) and 2021 International Building Code (IBC).
- The City's maximum ultimate design wind speed is 115 mph (V.ult). Exposure category "C"
- Ground snow load is 30 pounds per sqft
- 3.0 inches per hour for 100-year, 1-hour rainfall (for roof drain sizing)

## **General Requirements**

- A re-roofing permit is required when replacing more than 1 square (100 square feet) of roofing
- All rusted, damaged, or deteriorated: flashing, drain outlets, jacks and collars shall be replaced.
- Water damaged, rusted or deteriorated decking shall be removed and replaced
- Drip edge is required on all rakes and eves
- Ice and water is <u>not</u> required
- A minimum Class "C" rating is required for wood shake and wood shingles, per City amendment
- Wind clips are required for concrete tile and clay roofing installations
- If you are not replacing the entire roof, the area being replaced must terminate at a natural break in the roof (ie: valley, eve or ridge). At no time can you mix roofing materials or age of materials on a slope or facet of the roof unless allowed and warrantied by the product manufacturer.
