Please do not drive, park, or walk on the seal coating until all traffic cones and/or barricades have been removed (**at least 24 hours**). Seal coating may splatter onto vehicles and may damage shoes and clothing. It is very difficult to remove. Brown Brothers will not be responsible for the repair or replacement of vehicles, clothing, etc. caused by entry to the work areas before barricades are removed.
