




How To Measure Trail Distances



LONE TREE RECREATION CENTER - H11

10249 RidgeGate Cir.
The Lone Tree Recreation Center is a 54,000 square foot facility that includes leisure pools with water slide, lazy river, whirlpool, and lap lanes as well as a fitness area which includes cardiovascular machines, circuit equipment, and free weights. The center features numerous amenities including a full size gymnasium, fitness rooms and indoor running track.

TENNIS CENTER AND PARK AT LONE TREE GOLF CLUB - D8

The Tennis Center and Park has 6 tennis courts, 4 of which are lighted. There's a pro shop, picnic shelter, power outlets, drinking fountain, seasonal restrooms, playground, is ADA accessible, and has ample parking. The picnic shelter and tennis courts are available to rent.

COOK CREEK TENNIS COURTS - E5

There are 2 courts along with picnic and restroom shelters and a short trail and bridge spanning Willow Creek to the Willow Creek Trail and Sweetwater Park.

SCHWEIGER RANCH - J13

The 38-acre, historical Schweiger Ranch is open on a limited basis to the public for educational tours and community events. For more information, contact the ranch at 303-790-0557.

Other Amenities

COOK CREEK POOL - E6

8711 Lone Tree Pkwy.
The Cook Creek Pool consists of a 4,600 square foot leisure pool, 23' tower slide, zero depth entry to 3.5' deep, and includes a basketball and play area with an interactive water feature. There is also an 8 lane by 25 yard outdoor lap pool with depth ranges from 3.5' to 12.6' and a 1 meter diving board.

LONE TREE ARTS CENTER - F9

The Lone Tree Arts Center provides over 100 performances annually with a unique blend of national and international touring acts, performances by the state's top arts organizations, and originally produced performances. The venue is also a frequent meeting and event rental space.

LONE TREE GOLF CLUB & HOTEL - D8

The Lone Tree Golf Club & Hotel is a public course offering championship golf. The 18-hole, Arnold Palmer designed course provides golfers a country club setting available to everyone.



Regional Trails

EAST/WEST TRAIL - F13

The East/West Regional Trail offers panoramic views of the Denver metro area and Colorado front range mountains. Trail users can continue west and connect to the High Line Canal Trail outside the City of Lone Tree and to points beyond.

CENTENNIAL TRAIL - F2

The Centennial Trail closely follows state highway 470 stretching east and west. Trail users can travel west until the trail ends at the intersection of highway 470 and I-70, continue north to the South Platte Trail or travel east and connect to the Cherry Creek Trail.

WILDCAT TRAIL - B8

Wildcat Trail extends north and south along Lone Tree's western boundary. This trail begins at Quebec Street to the north and intersects with the East/West Trail to the south.

WILLOW CREEK TRAIL - D1

The Willow Creek Trail runs north and south through the center of Lone Tree. Trail users can travel north and connect to the High Line Canal Trail or continue south to Prairie Sky Park, the Lone Tree Recreation Center and the East/West Trail.
