CITY OF LONE TREE POLICE DEPARTMENT RIDE-ALONG PROGRAM

The City of Lone Tree Police Department is pleased that you have chosen to participate in our Ride-Along Program. The purpose of the program is to allow persons to accompany an officer during a tour of duty for reasons of education, experience, public relations or other suitable motive. It is our hope that you will find this experience both informative and enjoyable. Please read the information and guidelines before completing this form.

You will be assigned to ride with a police officer on his/her duties. The officer will attend to his/her normal duties and will respond to all calls for service to which he/she is assigned. The officer will be happy to discuss his/her duties and responsibilities as much as time and circumstances will permit.

Police officers' duties can, and often do, involve physical danger and serious risks. The officer will not avoid or disregard duties which involve emergencies or danger simply because you are accompanying him/her. While every effort will be made to ensure your safety, the police officer's first responsibility will be to carry out his/her assigned duties. If you are in an emergency situation, you must immediately and without question comply with all orders or directions given to you by the officer.

We hope that you will enjoy your participation in the program. The following guidelines apply:

- 1. A background criminal history of the rider has been completed. Any Criminal Violation or Convictions must be approved on a case by case basis.
- 2. The rider has completed and signed a Hold Harmless Agreement.
- 3. The rider must not be under the influence of alcohol or narcotics.
- 4. The rider has written approval from a supervisor or the Chief of Police.
- 5. All rides are scheduled for 4 hours and supervisors will strive to schedule Ride-Along during the daylight hours.
- 6. Riders are expected to wear appropriate business / casual attire and behave appropriately. You should avoid wearing sweatshirt T-shirts, shorts, jeans, and other types of leisure apparel.
- 7. The preferred age for the Ride-Along is at least 15 years of age. Anyone under the age of 18 years of age must have signed parental approval.
- 8. The officer may terminate your ride at any time for persons who are unruly, fail to obey instruction, distract an officer from his/her duties, or at the discretion of the watch commander.
- 9. No weapons unless the rider is currently a certified law enforcement officer or has authorization from LTPD command staff.
