

Homeowner's Trash & Recycling Guide

Waste Connections of Colorado will collect unlimited household trash every week. Trash must be bagged and placed in a closed container. There is a 40-pound limit per can/bag, and all animal waste must be bagged. Waste Connections of Colorado will also collect up to 15 bags of yard waste per week. Branches and brush must be cut into 4-foot lengths and tied securely in 24-inch diameter bundles. Limit: 10 bundles per week.

Recycling is picked upon the same day as your trash, on an every-other-week schedule (see calendar). Make sure to place recycle bins a few feet from your trash and have it out at curbside by 7 a.m. on the day of collection. You may order a 96-gallon wheeled cart from the City of Lone Tree online at cityoflonetree.com.

Waste Connections of Colorado does not accept any liquid waste or batteries. A clean-up fee will be added if your trash contains these items.

For special pickups or large items such as construction debris, house cleanouts or furniture, call Waste Connections of Colorado at 303-288-2100 for more information.

At Your Door is the City's household hazardous waste service provider. They collect items that should not be recycled or placed in the trash. Call At Your Door at 1-800-449-7587 to obtain a quote and schedule a pickup. Electronics recycling is also available.

RECYCLE: aluminum, paper bags, cardboard, glass bottles/jars, junk mail, magazines/catalogs, newspaper, office paper, phone books, styrofoam, plastic, steel, aerosol cans, and milk/juice cartons

DO NOT RECYCLE: items with food waste, heat-resistant glass, batteries, stickers, light bulbs, napkins, paper towels, electronics, mirrors, plastic bags, paint, oils, and yard waste
