### Caring For Your Lawn



When it rains, fertilizers and plant chemicals run off your lawn into storm drains and streams, which can be harmful to humans and animals.



### *What you can do:*

- ✓ Use fertilizers sparingly
- ✓ Don't fertilize more than twice a year and never before a rain
- ✓ Consider using natural fertilizers such as compost or Bonemeal
- ✓ Select pest-resistant plants or try companion planting to reduce the need for garden chemicals
