On January 14, 2025, at about 6:17PM, a male party entered the Dillard's Store at the Park Meadows Retail Resort and shoplifted a \$600 item. Employees of the store reported the theft and officers were able to respond to the area quickly.

The suspect was seen running on foot west from the store, approached an SUV where he forcibly removed a female from the driver's seat and drove off. Officers in the area were able to place a tire deflation device under one of the tires and it slowly started to go flat while officers followed the vehicle. Near the intersection of Yosemite Street and East Panorama Circle in Arapahoe County, the driver lost control of the vehicle, now driving on only three tires and one rim, and the SUV ended up on its side. Officers were able to safely take the male suspect into custody.

Officers later learned the female who was removed from the SUV by the male suspect was actually with the male suspect and she was also placed into custody.

The male was identified as 32-year-old Fernando Gilbert-Olivarez and was charged with Theft, Motor Vehicle Theft, Eluding and was also booked in on a warrant for a previous eluding charge.

The female was identified as 37-year-old Lisa Ann Dolobacs from Thornton, Colorado. She was charged with Theft, False Reporting to Authorities, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, and also had several outstanding warrants.
