City of Lone Tree Celebrates Opening of New Justice Center

Lone Tree, Colorado - The City of Lone Tree will celebrate the completion of its new Justice Center with a ribbon-cutting ceremony on Tuesday, September 8, 2026, from 3:30 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. at the new Lone Tree Justice Center, 12707 High Note Avenue, Lone Tree (northwest corner of RidgeGate Parkway (westbound) and High Note Avenue).

The ribbon cutting marks the completion of a significant capital investment by the City designed to strengthen public safety, modernize municipal services, and better serve the community in the future.

“This Justice Center gives our Police Department and Municipal Court a modern facility they need to serve our community and protect the quality of life that makes Lone Tree such a special place to live, work and visit,” said Mayor Marissa Harmon. “We are grateful to the many City leaders, staff and partners whose vision and commitment made this day possible.”

The new 37,324 square-foot Justice Center on 10.8 acres brings the City’s Police Department and Municipal Court together in a modern, purpose-built public facility. The facility provides expanded space for court proceedings, law enforcement operations, community programs and administrative functions, while incorporating modern technology and security features to support efficient and effective service delivery. The Police Department will also benefit from expanded and purpose-built spaces designed to support law enforcement personnel and the increasing demand for public safety services.

The Municipal Court, previously located within the Lone Tree Civic Center in a residential neighborhood, will move to the new Justice Center, providing a more appropriate and efficient setting for court operations.

Some major features of the Justice Center include:

- Expanded courtroom and legal proceeding spaces to support current and future demand;
- Purpose-built areas for police operations, training, administration and staff support;
- Dedicated spaces for community engagement;
- Integrated technology and security systems to support efficient and effective operations;
- A secure and accessible environment for residents, visitors, court users and staff;
- Public plaza areas and landscaped outdoor spaces that create an inviting civic presence;
- New parking areas and pedestrian connections to improve access to the facility;
- 2,900-square-foot solar PV canopy;
- Designed as a series of pavilions in the landscape, rooted in the rolling grassland of the site;
- A native demonstration garden featuring water-efficient landscaping adapted to Colorado's climate; and
- Generous access to natural daylight throughout public spaces and staff work areas.

The Justice Center is located on land donated to the City by Coventry Development as part of the RidgeGate development. The property, east of Interstate 25 along RidgeGate Parkway, is part of a larger area in Lone Tree that includes the City's new Public Works facility that opened last month, and High Note Park, currently under construction.

Together with the new Public Works Operations facility, the Justice Center is one of two major capital projects undertaken by the City to address the current and future service needs of the community and ensure Lone Tree has the infrastructure and facilities necessary to provide high-quality municipal services.

The Lone Tree Justice Center will open to the public on Monday, September 14, 2026.

Front desk services for the Police Department and Municipal Court will be available, Monday through Friday, from 8 a.m. To 5 p.m.
